



Re: NOTICE ON THE POSTPONEMENT OF 25TH STATED MEETING

#### **Dear Esteemed Commissioners,**

Greetings in Christ, whose words read, "23 Everything is permissible, but not everything is beneficial. Everything is permissible but not everything builds up. 24No one is to seek his own good, but the good of other person" (1 Cor 10:23-24).

Our Standing Rules states that "The GAPCP shall held its annual assembly meeting, otherwise termed as General Assembly, on the third Tuesday and ensuing days of October..." (see Art. III, Sec. 1). GAPCP's 25th Stated Meeting on October 20-22, 2020 in Montalban, Rizal was set amid the adverse impact of CoVID-19 pandemic with its massive reach, spread, and death toll in the country bringing our numbers way beyond that of China, the origin of this pandemic.

Thus, this urgent notice, which meets the requirements prescribed by our Standing Rules (see Art. III, Sec. 2), was issued to reach an appropriate decision on the matter. The officers of the Executive Committee concurred on the **Postponement** of our **25<sup>th</sup> Stated Meeting** in the interests of the health and safety of CP commissioners and their families and their respective churches.

The following statements provide details and subsequent information on the postponement:

- Period of Postponement. On a special meeting on July 25, the Exec Com officers approved the recommendation on postponement and to schedule the resumption of the 25th Stated Meeting on October 19-21, 2021 depending on the circumstances.
- 2) Terms of Office and Membership. The Robert's Rules of Oder (11th ed.). pp. 490-491, states that the Committee members serve until their successors have been chosen. Thus, all committee officers and members (both Executive and Standing committees) would remain in place until the next Stated Meeting elected successors (i.e., October 2021).
- 3) Appeal for Action. We encourage our commissioners to continue sending your contributions so that GAPCP will be sustained and able to provide assistance whenever necessary during this season of pandemic. We also, enjoin our congregations and their members to pray with us as we ask God's mercy upon the church, the country, and the world in this trying times.

We enjoin everyone that we promote our common purpose. May God bless us all!

#### **Approved Actions**

From 24th GA Stated Meeting



The 24th Stated Meeting of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church of the Philippines held on October 21-24, 2019 was concluded at Davao Korean Union Church.



#### **Approved Bills and Overtures**

- The GAPCP approved that Christian Education Committee will organize regional activities: [1] Elders and Deacons' Orientation on Office and Functions along with Parliamentary Procedures (i.e., August 2020 for Luzon, December 2019 for Visayas, and April 2020 for Mindanao), and [2] Training for Sunday School Teachers of every local churches. This was referred to the Finance Committee for budget considerations and was granted a total of \$\mathbb{P}\colon 20,000.\frac{\theta}{2}\$ to ensure that the program of activities will be delivered.
- GAPCP approved that Church Auxiliaries Committee organize a 3-day Youth Leaders
  Convention on June 17-19, 2020. Permission was granted to the committee to raise funds
  intended to cover the projected expenses for this event. The committee was granted a sum of
  P20,000 only as operational and preliminary funds for the event.

- 3. The Assembly agreed to honor the request from Bicol Presbytery for the assembly to recognize Rev. Ronald Contante as a denomination's missionary to Cambodia. As a token of this decision, GAPCP will provide a conditional support of P5,000 per month for no more than 6 months only to his aid, depending on the availability of funds through the appropriation to the Missions Committee. Further, the Committee was granted permission to raise funds for missionaries referred to them (including Rev. Ronald Contante).
- 4. The Assembly granted permission for Cavite Presbytery to assist the selling of a 204 sqm lot property of Crown of Glory Presbyterian Church at Mulawin, Tanza, Cavite, which proceeds will be utilized to purchase a parcel of land in a more strategic location (i.e., Brgy. Punta) along with the construction of a structure for the church.
- The Assembly resolved that all churches under GAPCP to [1] include 'Presbyterian Church'
  in the names of their respective churches and [2] use the logo of GAPCP in place of any other
  logo developed by presbyteries and churches.
- GAPCP approved that the Executive Committee will initiate and facilitate the conduct
  of another comprehensive Church survey which will commence during Summer of 2020. This
  initiative was granted a sum of P20,000, which will be taken from the budget of the Committee.
- 7. GAPCP approved to task the Missions Committee to raise funds, which will be used to support missionaries under their care. Approval was granted to the Committee to collect P70 per month for 24 months from all churches under the GAPCP. Part of the amount to be collected will be used to support Rev. Elimar Eleazar with a sum of P20,000 per month, following his deployment.

- GAPCP approved the Theological Statement revised by the Theological Education
   Committee from the initial document submitted to the 23<sup>rd</sup> Stated Meeting. The
   Committee was tasked to facilitate all presbyteries conformity to the statements (see copy of
   the Theological Statement as attached in this document).
- 9. The Assembly allowed that Bible Woman serving PCP in full time capacity will be dubbed as "Pastora." The term will only be given to women in the ministry who met these qualifications: [1] they will be required to earn a pastoral degree from a Bible school duly recognized by the GAPCP, [2] they have taken Bible subjects, studies on the shorter catechism and all GAPCP Standards (i.e., Church government, reformed worship, church discipline), [3] they were placed in the necessary procedure for assessing and interviewing of ministerial candidates and licensure within the presbytery, [4] they will be allowed to pursue licensure and not ordination, thus, they will not be granted permission to officiate the sacrament and pronounce the benediction during public worship, and [5] they will be placed under the care and supervision of their respective presbytery yet not be considered a member thereof.
- 10. GAPCP granted permission to the Missions Committee to collect Missions Offering from GAPCP churches through their respective presbytery every April and September of each year, in which 90% of the collection will be utilized by the presbyteries while 10% of the collection be used to augment the fund requirements of the Committee to support local and foreign mission work.



#### THEOLOGICAL STATEMENTS

#### (Revised by Theological Education

Committee, GAPCP General Assembly, Oct. 21-24, 2019)

- The purpose of GAPCP Seminaries and Bible Schools is to train ministers, missionaries, leaders, and teachers for Reformed theology and Presbyterian church polity. We accept the Westminster Confessions (1647), the 12 Articles of GAPCK, and other classic and historic confessions of the Reformed and Presbyterian churches as standard for faith and practice.
- We affirm the Divine Inspiration, Truthfulness, and Authority of both the Old and New Testament Scriptures in their entirety as the only written Word of God, without error in all that it affirms, and the only Infallible rule of faith and practice.
- We believe in the One Eternal God, the Creator and Lord of the heavens and the earth; the Triune Godhead—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, who govern all things according to the purpose of His will.
- We believe that Jesus Christ is the only Savior and Lord who redeemed us from all our sins. Religious diversity is practiced in the Philippines, but we reject the theology of religious pluralism.
- We believe in the person, power, and ministry of the Holy Spirit. Our doctrine of the Holy Spirit follows the Reformed interpretations as stated in its classic Creeds and Confessions.

- We believe that the Church of Christ is the gathering of God's covenant people—not a building. An
  organized local Church of Christ consists a significant number of baptized members, with an ordained
  minister, and elders.
- The Sacraments of the Church consist of Holy Communion and Baptism. We practice infant baptism for infants of Christian parents as members God's covenant people.
- We believe that Jesus Christ will return personally and visibly, in power and glory, to consummate His
  salvation and judgment. In principle, we follow the Reformed interpretation in matters of
  eschatology—not that of Dispensationalism.
- 9. Following the conservative Reformed stance, the GAPCP does not permit the ordination of women.
- 10. We also believe that the practice of same sex marriage is contrary to Biblical authority, and thus clearly violates God's design for a Christian family.
