DRAFT OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

for the **28th Stated Meeting** at Heneral Uno Presbyterian Church, Gen. Trias City



The 27th Stated Meeting of Cavite Presbytery (CP) of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church of the Philippines (GAPCP) commenced on August 2, 2025, at 9:20 A.M., at Jesus the Only Redeemer Church, B64, L3-4, P4, Elisa Homes, Molino 4, Bacoor City. The theme for the Stated Meeting was “*Growing Together*” based on Acts 2:42-47. The Moderator, Rev. Francis Bañaga, being in the chair, was present. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as corrected.

Opening Service (9:20 AM)

Rev. Genarus Ignacio presided over the opening worship with the JTOR Worship Team leading the worship singing. The Moderator preached God’s Word for all present. Rev. Joel Gallandez administered the Sacrament of the Lord’s Supper with CP Elders assisting. The benediction was pronounced by GAPCP General Secretary, Rev. Orlando Tabotabo.

Call to Order (10:50 AM)

Motion: Rev. Francis Bañaga, the Moderator, elicits the approval of the Presbytery to appoint Rev. Charles Alcid as an interim Recording Clerk, in the absence of the duly elected Recording Clerk and the resignation of the duly elected Vice Moderator mid-term. The action was favorable with the Presbytery. The affirmative has it.

There were twenty (20) Ministers, none of the missionaries, and eight (8) Elders present, sufficient to declare a quorum.

The Moderator recognized the presence of the Ministerial Candidate, other members, and observers; namely, Pastors Abraham Cacam, Marl Gabileo, Christopher Lomio, Jose Noel Lozano Sr., Danal Aguado, Mark Nestor Moreno, and Rev. Lemuel Dalisay (honorary member).

Declaration of Quorum (11:10 AM)

The Moderator, Rev. Francis Bañaga, declared a quorum and the 27th Stated Meeting of Cavite Presbytery in order.

Adoption of Docket (11:15 AM)

Motion: Rev. Orlando Tabotabo moved to adopt the proposed docket of the 27th Stated Meeting, with flexibility on schedule. The motion was seconded. The affirmative has it.

Action: The motion was approved.

Reading and Approval of the Previous Minutes (11:25 AM)

Motion: Rev. Crisostomo Sibulo moved to approve the minutes of the 27th Stated Meeting as corrected. The motion was seconded. The affirmative has it.

Action: The motion was approved.

Recess for Lunch (12:00 NN)

Resumption of Meeting (1:06 PM)

The Moderator, Rev. Francis Bañaga, recognized some guests: Rev. Arturo Panopio, visiting from Busan, South Korea; Rev. Saubel Salamat of Bread from Heaven Christian Fellowship; and Elder Leonardo Canto, Treasurer of the GAPCP.

Executive Committee Report (1:13 PM)

The Moderator, Rev. Francis Bañaga, reported the following accomplishments of the Executive Committee:

1. The Committee actively engaged in the coordination of the following events along with the concerned Standing Committees:
 - Committee members initiated the **Monthly Members' Fellowships**: with the Education Committee (March 2025), the Exam and Assessment Committee (April 2025), the Ministerial Affairs Committee (June 2025), and the Finance Committee (July 2025).
 - The Moderator initiated a coordination meeting for the **CP Youth Reorganization** participated in by representatives from different CP churches in March 2025. This marks the preparation for the ECHO: Sound + Doctrine **Camp by the CP Youth**, held at the Unida Christian Center, Silang, on May 20-22, 2025.
 - The Committee actively engaged in coordinating the **Ordination Ceremonies** for the following ordinands: Rev. Aljay Mondigo-Leones (March 9, 2025) and Rev. Joel Gallandez (June 15, 2025).
 - The Committee actively engaged in coordinating the **Confirmation of Ordination** to the following: Rev. Gil Hiponia (May 25, 2025) and Rev. John Teodoro (June 29, 2025).
 - The Committee actively engaged in coordinating the **Welcoming Service** to the Papaya Fellowship on July 20, 2025.
 - The Committee members coordinated on the **GAPCP's 38th Anniversary** celebration held on June 12, 2025, at the InShil Chapel. The celebration was initially thought to be an observance by Presbytery, but during the coordination meeting among Presbytery Moderators, it became a consensus to have it observed jointly among neighboring presbyteries. The Cavite Presbytery then became the host for the following presbyteries: NCRP – South Metro, Cavite Presbytery, representatives from NCRP – North Metro, and representatives from Southern Luzon Presbytery.
2. The Committee members initiated the necessary coordination with the respective families in honoring the **Defunct Members** due to their deaths.
 - Committee members coordinated with the family of Rev. Arman Mendoza on the schedules for those offering Necrological Services during his wake. The Moderator initiated coordinating with the family and the leadership of PTSCAS to offer the family the InShil Chapel as a venue for the viewing nights.
 - Cavite Presbytery offered a night to honor the life of Rev. Arman Mendoza on February 19, 2025. That was followed by schedules for the GBCM, PTSCAS, etc.
 - The Moderator coordinated with the family of Pastor Nelson Vitug on the schedules for those offering Necrological Services during his wake.

- Cavite Presbytery offered a night to honor the life of Pastor Nelson Vitug on July 4, 2025. That was followed by schedules for the AMW Churches, the Transformation Church, etc.
 - The Committee actively engaged in ensuring that the agreement on the collection of financial support to the bereaved families (both for Rev. Arman Mendoza and Ptr. Nelson Vitug) and helped raise funds to cover the series of hospitalizations, viewing, and interment, esp. by following up on the announcements and collections by the Treasurer.
3. The Committee was represented in the **Transition of Pastoral Assignment** at the GBCM. Immediately following the demise of Rev. Arman Mendoza, the Moderator requested the presence of Rev. Charles Alcid to help facilitate the pastoral assignment at the GBCM. Members of the Committee met with his family, the leaders of the church, and the interim pastor, Rev. Nicodemus Pagua. Guidance was provided for the initial meetings on the necessary support to the bereaved family, the election of Rev. Nick Pagua, and his transition to the pastoral assignment at the GBCM.
 4. The Moderator followed up on the transactions to **Sell the NJPC Church Building** in Sitio Pook, Paliparan, Dasmariñas City, through the *ad hoc* Committee, etc.
 5. The Moderator conducted **Church Visitation and Preaching** in the following CP Churches: *Dasmariñas Presbyterian Church* (joint Easter Worship on April 20, 2025), *The Shepherd Presbyterian Church* (4th Anniversary on April 27, 2025), *Saving Grace GMA Presbyterian Church* (31st Anniversary on June 1, 2025), *Heneral Uno and Trinidad Presbyterian Churches* (6th and 1st Anniversaries on June 15, 2025), and *Christ Above All Christian Church* (Anniversary on June 15).

Action: The report was filed.

The Treasurer’s Report (1:25 PM)

The Treasurer, Rev. Genusus Ignacio, reported the Summary of Cash Flow covering February 2025 – August 2025.

The Cavite Presbytery’s restricted funds (i.e., PASARE, SABAS) were still in the “*And Account*” at BDO Brookeside Branch, whose passbook was in the custody of the Treasurer, amounting to ₱299,860.⁸¹.

GAPCP Updates (1:55 PM)

The General Secretary of GAPCP, Rev. Orlando Tabotabo, reported the following:

1. The General Secretary represented the Executive Committee at the GAPCP Presbyteries' events and needs. He spoke at the anniversary celebrations of Capas First Presbyterian Church and God's Workers Presbyterian Church.
2. The Moderators of different Presbyteries were gathered for a meeting via Zoom in preparation for the upcoming 39th GAPCP Anniversary celebration.
3. The office issued the necessary documents by the Ministers and churches: Usufruct agreement between GAPCP and the Capas First Presbyterian Church; GIS and SEC documents for Heneral Uno Presbyterian Church's intent to purchase a property and have it registered under the name of the GAPCP; documentary requirements for the renewal of family Visa for Eonwook Kim; documentary requirements for the visa renewal for the family of Majid Ashaq (Pakistani enrolled at the PTSCAS for graduate programs); and CRASM renewal documents for Rev. Pablo Wangdale.
4. The General Secretary endeavored to assist the Moksu Academy in securing the necessary processing for the TESDA accreditation for the carpentry program; and securing an updated GIS for the Sungkwang Wave of Joy and Sungkwang Global Leadership Academy.





On the Activities and Salient Accomplishments

The Committee actively engaged in the coordination of the following activities along with the concerned Standing Committees:


- Committee members initiated the **Monthly Members' Fellowships** in September 2025, followed by different standing committees assigned respectively.


